

1. You are looking for an article from *The Craftsman* that was about the dining room being a center of good cheer in the home. You know that the phrases “dining room” and “good cheer” appear in the article title, but you’re not sure of the exact title of the article.
 - Click the **Advanced** tab to access this area.
 - Type *dining room and good cheer* into the field, then choose **Document title** from the pull-down menu.
 - On the next row, type *Craftsman* into the field, then choose **Publication title** from the pull-down menu.
 - Click **Search**.
2. You want to find information about the labor movement of the early 20th century.
 - Click the **Basic** tab to access this area.
 - Type *labor and strike* into the search field, then choose **Citation and Abstract** from the pull-down menu.
 - Enter a date range for your results: click the radio button beside **From** in the **Date range** section, then enter the following dates into the fields: *01/01/1895* to *01/01/1945*
 - Click the tab **More Search Options** (beneath date range limiters).
 - Using the pull-down menu for **Sort results by**, choose **Most relevant first**.
 - Click **Search**.
3. You want to find images of and information about friezes used in early 20th century interior design.
 - Click the **Publications** tab to access this area.
 - Click on the *W* to find titles that begin with this letter; scroll down in the list to find *Wall-Paper News and Interior Decorator*. Click on this title to go to the publication page.
 - From the publication page for *The Wall-Paper News and Interior Decorator*, type *frieze* into the field to Search for articles within this publication.
 - Click **Search**.
4. You want to find information about American photographer Alfred Stieglitz.
 - Click the **Basic** tab to access this area.
 - Type *Alfred Stieglitz* into the search field.
 - Click **Search**.



Sample Searches: American Periodicals from the Center for Research Libraries

- The search will return various articles about Alfred Stieglitz and his work. To find images of his photographs, scroll down on the results page to the search form beneath. Click the tab **More Search Options** (beneath date range limiters).
- Using the pull-down menu for **Document type**, restrict your search to **Photograph**.
- Click **Search** again to return some photographs by Alfred Stieglitz.
