



Sample Searches: ProQuest Historical Newspapers™

1. Find photos of Amelia Earhart.
 - Select the Basic search tab and enter Amelia Earhart in the search box.
 - Click the **More Search Options** link below the Date range limiters.
 - Expand the **Document type** menu and select **Photo standalone**.
 - Click **Search**.
2. Find front page articles about the first walk on the moon in July 1969.
 - Select the Basic search tab and enter “walk on the moon”. (Remember: Use quotation marks to find exact phrases for 3 word queries or longer.)
 - Enter the **Date range** From: 06/01/1969 To: 07/31/1969, to find articles leading up to the walk and after the walk.
 - Click the **More Search Options** link below the Date range limiters.
 - Expand the **Document type** menu and select **Front page**.
 - Click **Search**.
3. Find pictures of Mount Rushmore in the Rotogravure Picture section of the New York Times.
 - Select the Advanced search tab. Enter rotogravure in the first search row and select **Section** from the drop down menu.
 - Enter Mount Rushmore in the next search row.
 - Click **Search**.
4. Find articles authored by Albert Einstein.
 - Select the Basic search tab.
 - Click the **More Search Options** link below the Date range limiters.
 - Enter Albert Einstein in the **Author** search field. (Note: The author field searches for the first name and last name within proximity of each other. Therefore, you may enter last name first or first name first.)
 - Click **Search**.
5. How can I find the front page of my birthday issue of the newspaper?
 - Select the Publications tab.
 - If your library offers multiple ProQuest Historical Newspaper titles, select the newspaper title of your choice by clicking the appropriate link that corresponds to the date range in which your birthday falls.
 - On the resulting Publication page, find the **Browse specific issues** area. Select your birth month in the **View issues from** and **To** menus and enter your birth year. Example: Select September and enter 1968 in both of the **Browse specific issues** menus. Click **Browse Issues**.

- Click the link to your birthday issue. Example: Click link to Sep 25, 1968.
- The articles are displayed alphabetically by title. Expand the **Sort results by** menu in the right hand corner of results list and select **Sort by page number**.
- The articles are now in page order with front page articles listed first. Select the **Page Map** (low resolution image for navigation purposes) link or the **Article Image – PDF** link for the first article.
- Once you are viewing the **Page Map** or **Article Image – PDF**, you may select **Page Image – PDF** (high resolution image for reading/printing/saving) from **Other available formats**, to display the full page image.
