



## Sample Searches: The Paley Center Seminars

1. You are interested in the intersection of news and comedy.
  - Type *news and comedy* into the **Keyword(s)** field.
  - Click **Search**.
2. You are interested in finding seminar chapters that contain actors' in-depth conversations about working with an accent.
  - Click the **select from a list** link next to the **Subject** field.
  - Check the box next to *Accents* in the list, then click **Select**.
  - Click **Search**.
3. You want to find if people in the television business still talk about "Buffy, the Vampire Slayer" since the show ended in 2003.
  - Type *buffy* into the **Keyword(s)** field.
  - Scroll down to the **Date** field. On the **From** line, type *2004* in the year box.
  - Click **Search**.
4. As an aspiring director, you're very interested in finding out more about the musical choices other directors have made.
  - Type *music near (cho\* or select\*)* into the **Keyword(s)** field.
  - Click **Search**.

NOTE: To get the most out of your search, find variations on the words "choice" and "select" using the truncation symbol (\*). For example, a search on *cho\** will retrieve results with the terms choice, choices, etc. and a search on *select\** will retrieve results with the terms select, selection, etc.

5. As an acting student, you're interested in learning more about casting at the various networks, starting with ABC.
  - Type *ABC* into the **Keyword(s)** field.
  - Click **Search**.
  - On the search results page, click **Subject** (in the **Filter Results By** panel).
  - Click **Casting**
6. You know that Martin Scorsese has worked with the same editor for all of his films since 1980's "Raging Bull," but you're not certain of her name.
  - Type *"martin scorsese"* into the **Keyword(s)** field.
  - Click **Search**.
  - On the search results page, click **Subject** (in the **Filter Results By** panel).
  - Click **Editing – Movies**.

7. You've heard that William Shatner played a villain on a television drama a couple of times and you'd like to find a conversation about that show.
  - Click **select from a list** next to the **Participant** field.
  - Type *shatner* in the search box above the list, then click **Look For**.
  - Check the box next to *Shatner, William* in the list, then click **Select**.
  - Type *villain* into the **Keyword(s)** field.
  - Click **Search**.
