



Sample Searches: ProQuest Science Journals

1. You want to find articles about instruments (technology) to detect or measure seismographic or seismological activities in relation to earthquakes.
 - Click the **Basic** tab to access this area.
 - Enter the keywords *seismo* W/15 instruments AND earthquake** into the search box
 - Click **Search**.

2. You want to find articles that have been subject-indexed as genetically altered foods and that refer to a study or studies. Look for articles published in scholarly journals and before October 31st, 2008. Mark some of the articles found.
 - Click the **Advanced** tab to access this area.
 - Click on the **Browse Topics** link in the grey toolbar above the search boxes
 - Click on the **Thesaurus** link on the right-hand upper side.
 - Enter *Genetics* into the search box and click on **Find Term**
 - Click on the narrower term *Genetic Engineering* to find an exact entry for *Genetically Altered Foods*. Click on this link and click on the **Add to Search** button.
 - Enter the operator AND and your keyword: *stud**
 - Click on the drop-down-menu for Date range and select Before this date. Enter *10/31/2008*
 - Click on the tic-box left to the selection: **Scholarly journals, including peer-reviewed** only
 - Click **Search**.
 - Click on the tic-boxes left to some of the articles to mark them.

3. You want to find articles that are subject-indexed as oil exploration and refer to offshore oil exploration. Look for articles that focus on the company British Patrol / BP.
 - Click the **Advanced** tab to access this area.
 - Enter *oil exploration* into the first search box and select **subject** from the drop-down-menu next to it.
 - Enter *British Patrol OR BP* into the second search box and select **company** from the drop-down-menu next to it.
 - Enter the keywords *sea OR offshore* into the third search box and select **Citation & Abstract** from the drop-down-menu next to it.
 - Click **Search**.

4. You want to find articles that are subject-indexed as renewable resources that contain figures or tables.
 - Click the **Advanced** tab to access this area.
 - Click on the **Browse Topics** link in the grey toolbar above the search boxes
 - Click on the **Thesaurus** link on the right-hand upper side.

- Enter *renewable resources* into the search box and click on **Find Term**.
 - Click on the **Add to Search** button.
 - Click on the drop-down menu next to the next search box and select **Image caption**.
 - Enter *figure OR table* into this search box.
 - Click **Search**.
5. You want to find book reviews that let you identify monographic works on stem cell research. Note, that some authors type stem-cell.
- Click the **Advanced** tab to access this area.
 - Enter the keywords *stem cell OR stem-cell AND research* into the search box and select **citation & abstract** from the drop-down menu.
 - Click on the drop-down menu of the next search box and select **Article Type**. Click on the Browse **Article Type** link to find out which article types are indexed: select **review**.
 - Click **Search**.
6. You want to find the article “Throwing light on dark energy”, published in Science, Washington, in June 20, 2003. Email the article to yourself and search for more articles in Science like this.
- Click the **Publications** tab to access this area.
 - Enter the keyword *Science* into the search box and scroll to the link for Science, Washington. (Or type “*Science*” to search for the exact phrase) and click on the journal title link.
 - Click on the issue link for **June 20, 2003** and browse the table of contents and click on the **article title**.
 - Click on the button **email** in the left corner on the top of the article. Check the tic box before **full text format**.
 - Go back to the list of issues and click on the **Search within publication-tab** above the list of issue box.
 - Enter *dark matter* into the search box.
 - Click **Search**.
7. You want to print out a pure bibliography without abstracts of your marked articles in the bibliographic format of the American Medical Association (AMA)
- Click on **Marked List** in the top-menu-bar to access this area.
 - Click on the **Print** button and check the tic-box left to the selection for the *AMA-style*. Make sure the format tic-box **citations only** is checked and click on print.

8. You want to revise your session: Keep some of the articles on *genetically altered foods*, save the search on *renewable sources* for future runs of this search and save a direct link to the journal *Science*. Save this summary of the session to come back to it another time.
- Click on **Marked List** in the top-menu-bar and then on the tab **My research summary**
 - Click on **Edit the information below**
 - Uncheck some of the tic-boxes left to the marked article list
 - Uncheck all searches, except the one you would like to keep (don't click on the link **Remove all articles and don't show this group** as long as you want to keep any searches)
 - Check for the journal *Science* to be there and checked
 - Click on the **Update** button
 - Click on the link **Download** and save the session via the Browser-menu
